#17. There have been no exams given for the last 15 months because of an accreditation issue regarding the California Association for Alcohol/Drug Educators. The problem has been resolved by the formation of a new certifying board, Addiction Counselor Certification Board, which has been allowed to resume certifications as of the end of March 2019. Therefore, we have no state exam results to report for the last two cycles.
